Interesting Facts and Award Recognition

- IHIE is one of 5 regional collaboratives participating in a pilot project (646) with the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS). The project leverages the Quality Health First program by providing physicians with information that will help them keep track of certain screenings and how effective follow-up treatments are to their Medicare patient population as a whole.
- In 2009, IHIE became part of the nation's first live, multi-region clinical information exchange (covering Indiana and Ohio) along with HealthBridge (Cincinnati) and HealthLINC (Bloomington).
- IHIE also is a national "best-practice" and participates in several federally-funded initiatives along with housing the Indianapolis Coalition for Patient Safety.
- *U.S. News & World Report* featured IHIE in August 1, 2005 issue, declaring IHIE is "...at the forefront of an effort to streamline the nation's chaotic healthcare delivery system."
- In 2007, Regenstrief Institute Inc., was awarded a share of a \$22.5 million contract to begin trial implementations of a Nationwide Health Information Network (NHIN). IHIE is lending support to this effort.
- IHIE and Regenstrief Foundation received a substantial share of an \$18.6 million contract from the U.S. Dept. of Health and Human Services as 1 of 4 national
